The Seventh South South Forum on Sustainability

Climate Change, Global Crises, and Community Regeneration

The First South South Forum on Sustainability (SSFS) was organized by Lingnan University and Global University for Sustainability in December 2011, with over 10 co-organizing universities or institutions from Hong Kong, mainland China, and overseas. Most overseas participants joined four exchange visits to rural and urban areas in mainland China. The Second SSFS was held in Chongqing in December 2012. Since the Third SSFS in 2016, the Forum has become an annual event in early summer in Lingnan University. The Seventh SSFS focuses on the theme of “Climate Change, Global Crises, and Community Regeneration”. As a continuation of the debates of previous forums on reviewing critical situations and exploring alternatives, the Seventh SSFS aims to examine the current state of affairs, including the COVID-19 pandemic, the New Cold War, nuclear weapons proliferation, nuclear power plant catastrophes, climate change, weather extremities, environmental pollution, food and fresh water shortages, US geopolitical and currency domination, and the US sanctions against Venezuela, Iran, and China.

Taking note of the consequences and effects on nature and on peoples especially those from the global south, the Forum has brought together academic scholars, feminists, peace activists, community workers, food producers, and rural regeneration promoters to review, articulate and debate theories and practices in transformative and collective actions called forth by the crises of capitalism affecting the ecological, the social, the political, and the economic.

Drawing upon experiences of community governance in Asia, Africa and Latin America, the Forum is a platform for dialogues and exchanges among grassroots and resistance practices in the production, dissemination and use of knowledge as instruments of problematization and self-organization, as well as interactions among thinkers in search of paradigms for peace and justice.

2011年12月，岭南大学和全球大学在香港共同主办第一届南南论坛。2012年12月，在重庆举办第二届南南论坛。从2016年第三届南南论坛开始，每年初夏在岭南大学举行，合办机构包括中国和海外高等院校、学术机构、妇女组织、乡建团体等。

自2011年以来，南南论坛已成功举办六届大会，邀请来自世界各地关心生态及发展问题理论和实践领域的专家、学者、实践者等近千人汇聚一堂，就另类发展、生态可持续等议题进行深入的对话和交流。同时，大会还组织了多次考察团让参与者到中国的城乡参观交流，增进海外人士对中国乡土社会现状和发展的认识。

Feminist Yearning, Imagining, and Organizing for Just Peace and Genuine Security

14-15 July 2020

The current moment — Corona Pandemic combined with global uprisings and state responses to both — demands us feminists around the world to stand in solidarity. To do so, we must take the time to think together across regions and other “borders” in order to understand more fully the current conditions and political situations in various regions—including gender, race/ethnicity, class/caste, indigeneity, and sexuality, for example—and in more nuanced ways; to imagine feminist futures that will be able to secure livelihoods, sustain the natural environment and ensure the dignity and wellbeing of all living beings; and to organize transnationally as feminists.

We recognize that neo-liberal capitalism, Right-Wing populism and nationalism, religious fundamentalisms and hatred toward certain religions, militarism, colonialism, and imperialism form the foundations of the world in which we exist. Through and from these, region-specific forms of patriarchy and male dominance, anti-Blackness and other forms of racism, ethnocentrism, class, and caste, heterosexism and trans-phobia, ecological violence, and other life-destroying, intertwined forces are made manifest. Our workshops are organized to engage speakers and attendees collectively, across borders to analyze the current moment, gain deeper understandings of the cross-cutting issues and forces and the specifics of each location, share existing alternatives to current systems in place and imagine others, and inspire and support one another in our struggles and have fun as we face critical conditions around us.

女性主义者之向往、想象与组织：实现正义和平与真正安全 2020年7月14-15日

当前的时刻 —— 新冠疫情大流行结合全球的抗议，以及国家对这两者的反应 —— 要求我们全世界的女性主义者团结一致。为此，我们必须花时间超越地区和其他“边界”一起共同思考，以便更全面地、更细致的方式地了解各区域的当前状况和政治局势，例如性别、种族/族裔、阶级/种姓、原住民和性倾向等；设想女性主义的未来将能够确保生计，维持自然环境，确保所有生物的尊严和福祉；并组织跨国家的女性主义网络。

我们认识到，新自由资本主义、右翼民粹主义和民族主义、宗教原教旨主义和对某些宗教的仇恨、军国主义、殖民主义和帝国主义形成了现存世界的思想基础。由此，带有区域差异性的父权制和男权统治、仇恨黑人和其他形式的种族主义、种族中心主义、阶级和种姓、异性恋和跨性别恐惧症、生态暴力和其他破坏生命的行为相互交织而得以显现。我们组织研讨会，让演讲者和与会者共同参与，能够跨越国界：分析当前形势；深入了解跨领域的议题和力量以及每个地区的具体情况；分享现有系统的另类替代方案，并想象其他可能性，以及当我们面对周围严峻局势时互相激励。




